# I AM TODAY'S FILIPINO

PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEO EXHIBIT

I Am Today's Filipino documents the many stories of present-day Filipinos, one-hundred years after the first significant wave of Filipino migration to the United States. This exhibit provides an intimate glimpse into the individual lives and experiences that reflect the collective story of the Filipino community in Southern California in 2006. It preserves a moment in the current history of Filipinos in America and encourages a greater awareness of the many contributions that Filipinos have made and continue to make to American life. Through the artistic display of photos and video, this original exhibit celebrates the diversity of the Filipino community while recognizing the rich cultural heritage and traditions shared among all Filipinos.

This year, the Smithsonian Institute is leading the national commemoration of the 100th Anniversary of the arrival of the first significant numbers of Filipino immigrants who came in 1906 to work on the plantations of Hawaii. The migration filled the need for an expanded labor force that has become vital to the development of the United States. Today, Southern California is home to over one-million residents of Filipino descent, the largest Filipino population outside the Philippines.

This exhibit plans to open October 2006 to coincide with Filipino American Heritage Month on October 28-29 at Farmani Gallery. An additional exhibit and closing reception is scheduled at Remy's on Temple on January 6, 2007. Preview shows have been held at the Lotus Festival on July 8-9 and at the Historic Filipinotown Anniversary on August 5.

This first of its kind documentary exhibit is presented by Celina Taganas-Duffy of Tagline Communications and Ray Carbullido of Madskill Productions, in association with Search to Involve Pilipino Americans (SIPA) and FilAm Arts. This is an official project of the Los Angeles/Southern California Filipino American Centennial Planning Committee, which works in partnership with the Smithsonian Institute's Asian Pacific American Program and is supported by ABS-CBN/The Filipino Channel, Washington Mutual and Wells Fargo Bank.

#### THE EXHIBIT

Please join us in celebrating the Filipino American Centennial Celebrations through the installation of *I Am Today's Filipino*, a first of its kind photo and video exhibit that pays tribute to Filipinos in the United States.

It is the selected culminating event of the Los Angeles/Southern California Filipino American Centennial Planning Committee, which works in partnership with the Smithsonian Institute's Asian Pacific American Program.

The VIP Reception will take place from 6-9 pm on October 28, 2006 at Farmani Gallery in Beverly Hills, one of the leading galleries of Contemporary Photography in Los Angeles. The opening reception for the general public will be held from 12-3pm on October 29, 2006.

An additional exhibit is scheduled at Remy's on Temple in Historic Filipinotown from December 21, 2006 to January 7, 2007, with a closing reception on January 6, 2007.

#### THE FILIPINO MARKET

I Am Today's Filipino provides a unique opportunity for sponsoring businesses to access a largely untapped market: the Filipino Community. Currently there are approximately 2.3 million Filipinos, including those of mixed-race and mixed-ethnicity, residing in the United States.

Of the fifty states, California is home to the largest Filipino population with over one-million residents. Los Angeles has the highest concentration of Filipinos with approximately 300,000 residents.
